OPEN POSITIONS



Internal Manager

- This position mirror “Project Managers” position in real life

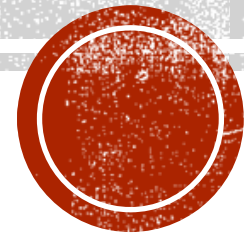


HOW TO APPLY FOR EXISTING POSITIONS

- **STEP 1. 2 OPTIONS TO SUBMIT HARD APPLICATION**
 - 1) Submit Resume to ae@ucsd.edu
 - OR 2) Fill out here:
 - You may add a cover letter (optional)
 - **Deadline:** Week 6, Monday, 11:59PM
- **STEP 2:** Prepare a 2 minute elevator pitch about yourself
 - You'll present that speech before the special election meeting (end of Spring Quarter)
- **STEP 3:** Official AEE members are eligible to Vote either at the meeting or via email if they cannot make it (hence you need to provide step 1)
- **STEP 4:** You'll be notified via email or phone. 1 month training before you adopt your position officially.
